Montgomery County Public Election Fund

Sidney is proud to participate in the Montgomery County Public Election Fund and have his campaign funded by people like you. What does it mean that Sidney is participating in this program? Here are some common questions and answers, and what you can do help.

Q: How does a candidate qualify for the public election fund?

A: As a district candidate for the Montgomery County Council, Sidney must raise at least \$10,000 from at least 125 Montgomery County residents to qualify for public financing. Once Sidney qualifies, he needs to continue raising money to receive the maximum amount of funding from the public election fund: \$125,000.

Q: What are the contribution limits?

A: Individuals can donate up to \$150.

Q: How does my donation help?

A: Montgomery County's public election fund is a matching program – that means candidates receive a certain amount from the fund for each donation. Here's how that works:

Q: Who can donate?

A: Sidney can accept up to \$150 from individuals, but only donations from Montgomery County residents count toward the matching funds. Groups or organizations, including political action committees, corporations, labor organizations, and State or local central committees of a political party, are prohibited from donating. Private contributions from a sole proprietor, LLC, or LLP are also prohibited.

Q: What can I do to help?

A: Make a donation! Every dollar helps Sidney run a campaign powered by people.
